### Course – John Sanders

Due to the inclement weather this week, no earthworks have been possible. It also means that no holes have been closed this week. All holes will be open next week also.

We began the removal of some trees on the left-hand side of the 5th fairway. Work has temporarily stopped due to the wet weather not allowing vehicle access. If any fallen trees have not been removed by the weekend, they will be considered GUR.

The wet weather has made the crossings over the truck routes very messy. As mentioned last week, final remediation including seeding or turfing can't occur until the spring, so in the meantime, the contractors are using rubber mats to provide safe crossing points, whose location will be indicated by cones. We are also doing all we can to improve the condition of the walkway past the sand-shed that we use to get from 11 to 12 and from 7 to 8. The new mounds combined with the heavy rain have caused water to pool in the walkway. Look for a vast improvement this weekend.

This week Marks team has been completing the mainline between the 9th and 10th fairways. No new work is scheduled for next week while Mark is on leave. This means all holes will be open next week

Mark has asked me to pass on his thanks to those volunteers who helped back-fill the irrigation trenches last week. This volunteer help is greatly appreciated and ensures the holes are back in play each weekend. Mark will be on leave next week, so no irrigation work will be undertaken and therefore no volunteers required. The course staff will be on normal course maintenance, with grass cutting being the highest priority.

Members playing last Sunday may have noticed white dots of foam on the greens. These are a result of Mark spraying them with a growth regulator. This may seem strange, especially in winter when growth is minimal anyway, but while it restricts growth vertically, it encourages the grass to grow horizontally, which aids in closing the gaps in the grass that are left from the coring/scouring process.
