Greens Maintenance

The scarifying and coring of our greens has gone very well this week, apart from one minor glitch with the contracting equipment. The greens have all been sanded and staff have been sweeping the greens to get as much sand as possible into each hole.

On Friday, Mark will be manually raking sand to fill any remining holes. Volunteers are once again requested to assist with this on Friday morning prior to the forecast rain. If you are available from 10am, please report to the office.

Staff will then blow any remaining sand off the greens to ensure grass is visible, otherwise it dies if left completely covered. Next week Mark will further check the greens and spread more sand if required, until all the holes are filled.
