The #1 drain work is almost complete. We are almost there! The main contractor has completed their work, seeding of the remaining areas should be completed by end of day today and Mark has completed the remaining irrigation on 17 and 2.

There are snags to resolve and some tidying work to do on turfing/repairing areas where the underground system has been installed, but from next week, the staff will be able to spend much more time on normal course maintenance.

From now on, greens will be cut most days and fairways/rough at least twice per week. The irrigation is now fully operational, so we will be able to attend to the areas that are very dry.

All holes will be back in full play from next week. On 17 and 2, Mark will rope off the newly grassed areas to be avoided, other than to retrieve your ball.

So, when do we think the newly grassed areas will be fully playable? The grass on each mound is growing at different rates and we are constantly monitoring them. Some are doing very well but the grass sown this week will not be ready for 10-12 weeks. We will keep you informed.
