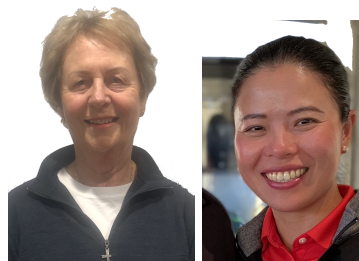
Hello Ladies,
